2021-22: I am working on two projects. The first, *The Science of Right*, currently focuses on the theory of rights and deontic logic in the Continental legal science of the Enlightenment. I am interested in these themes in the legal treatises of such jurists as Grotius, Vinnius, Domat, Pufendorf, Leibniz, and Achenwall. The second is an exploration of the 'secondary' law of nations, or *ius gentium*, as a method of legal proof, demonstrating legal validity by *argumentum ad consensum gentium*. I continue pursuing my general academic interests in the political theory and legal history of sovereignty, especially in the political and legal thought of Jean Bodin. The following are topics of shorter article-length studies (unfinished business from earlier work): (1) Bodin's theory of 'harmonic justice'; (2) historical-institutionalism in Bodin's theory of institutional change; (3) Bodin on the right of coinage and sovereign debt. I am exploring the feasibility of a longer-term project of textual scholarship to prepare *On the State*, a critical edition and English translation (first time since 1606) of the complete *Les Six Livres de la République/De Republica Libri VI* of Jean Bodin.
