**2020:** I am currently planning two new major book-length projects. One is entitled, *The Science of Right*, focusing on the theory of rights and deontic logic in Continental legal science, roughly from Gratian to Kant. The second is an exploration of the law of nations, or *ius gentium*, and its function in legal theory as the ‘consent of all mankind.’ I continue pursuing my general academic interests in the political theory and conceptual history of sovereignty. In the nearer-term, I plan to continue my work on the political and legal thought of Jean Bodin, focusing on the following topics in shorter article-length studies (unfinished business from earlier work): (1) Bodin’s theory of ‘harmonic justice’; (2) the exceptional qualities of democratic peoplehood; (3) Bodin’s category of ‘seigneurial’ (from *dominium*/Δεσποτεία) government; (4) historical-institutionalism in Bodin’s theory of institutional change. If I can have it properly funded and supported, I am exploring the feasibility of a longer-term project of textual scholarship to prepare *On the State*, a critical edition and English translation (first time since 1606) of the complete *Les Six Livres de la République/De Republica Libri VI* of Jean Bodin.
